The YMCA conducts regular sex offender screenings on all members, participants, and guests. If a sex offender match occurs, the YMCA reserves the right to cancel the membership, end program participation, and remove visitation access.

Waivers **MUST** be signed before entering the facility. Those under eighteen (18) **MUST** be signed for by a responsible adult, preferably a parent/guardian, with a valid ID. Those under thirteen (13) **MUST** be accompanied by a responsible adult aged 18 or over for the duration of the visit. Adults signing and staying are responsible for the safety and wellbeing of the guest as well as the upholding of our Code of Conduct.

YMCA of Pawtucket Code of Conduct

The **YMCA of Pawtucket** is committed to providing a Safe and welcoming environment for all members, guests and staff. To promote safety and comfort for all, all individuals are asked to act appropriately at all times when at our facility or participating in our programs. We expect persons using the **YMCA** to act maturely, to behave responsibly, and to respect the rights and dignity of others. Our Member's Ode of Conduct outlines prohibited behavior, but the actions listed below are not an all-inclusive list of behaviors considered inappropriate in our facilities or programs:

- Profanity or abusive language
- Harassment of any kind
- Behavior that is deemed by management as offensive or creates a situation that is considered to be unsafe.
- Theft of property
- Unwanted contact with other members
- Criminal conduct
- Use of tobacco products
- Consumption of illegal drugs or alcohol while on **YMCA** property
- Being under the influence of illegal drugs or alcohol while on **YMCA** property
- Fighting, roughhousing or aggressive play
- Spitting or expelling bodily fluid that may be unsafe
- Improper supervision of children
- Unauthorized solicitation and/or distribution of any kind
- Improper and unauthorized use of membership card
- Use of cell phones in the **YMCA's** shower and locker room areas
- Use of any video/picture taking equipment, including camera phones, in **YMCA's** shower room, locker rooms, and fitness center area

In addition, the **YMCA** reserves the right to deny access or membership to any person who has been accused or convicted of any crime involving sexual abuse, is or has been a registered sex offender, has ever been convicted of a violent act or any offense relating to the use, sale, possession, or transportation of narcotics or habit forming and/or dangerous drugs, or is presently or habitually under the influence of dangerous drugs or chemicals, narcotics or intoxicating beverages.

The Branch Executive Director reserves the right to suspend or terminate membership privileges if a violation of the Code of Conduct has occurred.
